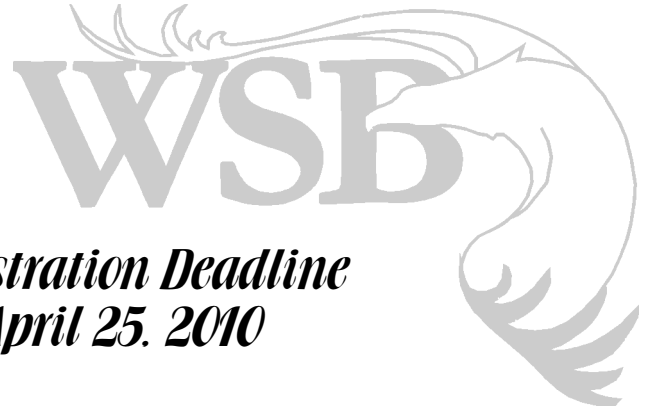


# REGISTRATION INFORMATION & FEES

*Registration Deadline*  
*April 25, 2010*

Registration and entry fee is required for all competing teams. All registration fees are payable directly to New Jersey Audubon's World Series of Birding. All fees, including Corporate Sponsorship and brunch fees, are due by May 5.

Official WSB shirt and attendance at the Awards Brunch is available to anyone not covered in the registration fee, including designated drivers, non-competing participants, and guests. Official WSB shirts (\$20) are available for purchase at the Finish Line and the Awards Brunch. Reservations and payment (\$25 per person) for Awards Brunch must be made in advance, no later than May 5.

## Designated Drivers

All designated drivers must register with their team but there is no entry fee. Designated drivers are just that. They are not to aid or contribute in location or identification of birds in any manner during the competition.

## Corporate Sponsor Entry Fee

Corporate sponsorship for any team requires a \$1,500 team entry fee plus \$115 per team member (except for designated drivers) which includes materials, Finish Line festivities, Awards Brunch, and an official WSB shirt for each team member (except designated drivers), and two Corporate Sponsors.

## Level I - Competing Teams

(includes all Level I categories)

### *Corporate Sponsored Team*

Corporate sponsored teams are required to pay the Corporate Sponsor entry fee as noted above. Any Corporate Sponsors supporting two or more Level I teams, in any Level I category, are required to pay an additional \$500 team entry fee plus \$115 per team member for any additional teams.

### *Independent Team*

Independent teams without corporate sponsorship are required to pay a \$115 per team member (except for designated drivers) entry fee. Includes materials, Finish Line Festivities, Awards Brunch, and official WSB shirt for each team member (except designated drivers).

## Level II: Non-Competing Team or Individual

**Anyone participating in the World Series of Birding must register.** There is no registration fee. Any pledges raised must benefit New Jersey Audubon. All pledges are to be submitted by July 1. Anyone wishing to raise pledges for any organization other than New Jersey Audubon, must register as a competing team and pay the appropriate registration fees. Official WSB shirts (\$20) are available for purchase at the Finish Line and the Awards Brunch. Reservations and payment (\$25 per person) for Awards Brunch must be made in advance, no later than May 5.

## Level III: Youth Challenge

### *Corporate Sponsored Youth Team*

Corporate sponsored Youth Teams are required to pay the Corporate Sponsor entry fee as noted above. Any Corporate Sponsors supporting two or more Youth teams, in any division, are required to pay an additional \$500 team entry fee plus \$115 per team member for any additional teams. Adults/designated drivers must register but there is no entry fee and does not include shirt or brunch. Official WSB shirts (\$20) are available for purchase at the Finish Line and the Awards Brunch. Reservations and payment (\$25 per person) for Awards Brunch must be made in advance, no later than May 5.

### *Corporate Sponsored Youth and Level I Team*

Corporate sponsored Youth Teams that also have a Level I participating team are required to pay the Corporate Sponsor fees as required for a Level I team, and a Corporate Mentor Entry Fee of \$500 plus \$30 per team member for each Youth Team which includes materials, Finish Line Festivities, medal, and official WSB shirt for each team member (except adults/designated drivers). **Brunch is not included.** Adults/designated drivers must register but there is no entry fee. Reservations and payment (\$25 per person) for Awards Brunch must be made in advance, no later than May 5.

### *Independent Youth Team*

Independent teams without corporate sponsorship are required to pay a \$50 per team entry fee plus \$5 per team member (except for adults/designated drivers) which includes
